Sunday: Catholic Schools Week Mass, St. Mary's Church 9:30am
OPEN HOUSE at school 11am-1pm

Students will wear school uniforms to mass and participate as Altar Servers, Lectors, Gift Bearers and Greeters. School families are invited to a breakfast served by Knights of Columbus at the school following the 9:30am mass (donations encouraged) while the school band performs. OPEN HOUSE includes school tours and classroom visits for new/perspective families.

Monday: Lounge-wear/Pajama Day & Faculty-Student Basketball Game

Students may wear appropriate pajamas and/or sweat pants and t-shirts to school. Tops must have sleeves (cannot be sleeveless or straps). All students must wear either pajama pants or pants under a nightshirt/nightgown. Tops must have sleeves and cannot be sleeveless or strap styles. Student/Teacher Basketball and Minute-to-Win-It games will take place.

Tuesday: Tacky Tuesday, Classroom Visits & Family Appreciation Day

Students may wear mismatched, backwards, or inside-out clothing. FAMILY APPRECIATION DAY! PARENTS CAN VISIT CLASSROOMS FROM 9:00-11:00am AND enjoy coffee, juice and donuts with your children in the Multipurpose Room between 8:30-9:00 am. Parents are encouraged to visit their child's current classroom as well as their child's teacher for next year.

Students may wear solid blue, yellow, or white clothing. The purpose is to be dressed head-to-toe in school colors. A stem presentation will be shown at 9:30am. Students will be served ice cream at lunch, will be given no homework and have an assembly.
